Problem:

A newly constructed luxury hotel on the lakeshore needed an attractive, durable, long-lasting waterproof membrane on all the balconies and stairs. The underside of these structures was finished with an acrylic stucco so it was necessary to completely waterproof the top surface.

Duradek Solution:

DURADEK IVORY CUSTOM (20 mil) was glued to T. & G. plywood and secured on the perimeters with mini-trim. The plywood staircases were covered on both riser and runner with a continuous vinyl sheet. Stair nosings were installed to protect the leading edge from abuse and excessive abrasion.
