Problem:

This 35 year old apartment complex had an underground parking garage that was leaking. The original waterproofing was a "between-slab" roofing membrane which had failed. Tenants were forced to build tarp structures over their vehicles to protect them from dripping water. Steel structural materials were at risk because of all the water. The deck surface over the garage, which many of the tenants looked onto, was an eyesore.

Duradek® was then applied over the entire surface and 6 inches up the wall, where it was mechanically terminated.
